**Tournament Information and Rules Agreement Form**

- Players must not reach higher age prior to May 1, 2011
- Copies of birth certificates must be available for review at any time during tournament.
- In the event of the championship game being rained out, trophies will be given out to the two top highest seeds (according to tie-breaker rules).
- No pre-game infield of batting practice on the field. Use of existing on-site batting cages not permitted.
- Home team will be determined by the flip of a coin prior to the start of each pool game.
- The home team is responsible for keeping the official scorebook.
- All participants are competing at their own risk and by participating agree to hold all tournament officials, all facilities and their owner and directors, all sponsors, and any other person or organization associated with this tournament harmless from any liability resulting from participating in the tournament.
- Umpires will work to settle all problems on the field. The umpire in Chief will have final say in these matters. Protests will be allowed for age and pitching violations or rules interpretations only. Protest must be declared to umpire before next pitch following the dispute. No protests will be allowed following the game. Tournament director will rule on all protests and their decision is final. Protest fee is \$50 cash and will be refunded if protest is allowed.
- All players, coaches, and fans will be expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner at all times. Any player, coach or parent/fan whose conduct is unbecoming or abusive will at a minimum be warned and may be removed from the playing field or stands at the direction of the tournament official or the umpire. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
- Smoking is not allowed on the Lincoln Little League grounds and pets are not permitted.

**Pool Play Tie-Breaker Rules**

- Overall points, 2 for a win and 1 for a tie
- Head to head competition
- Fewest runs allowed
- Run differential (max of 10)
- Runs scored
- Coin flip

In the event of a three way tie, the head to head tie breaker is eliminated. If two teams tie in fewest runs allowed, then head to head competition comes back into play.
